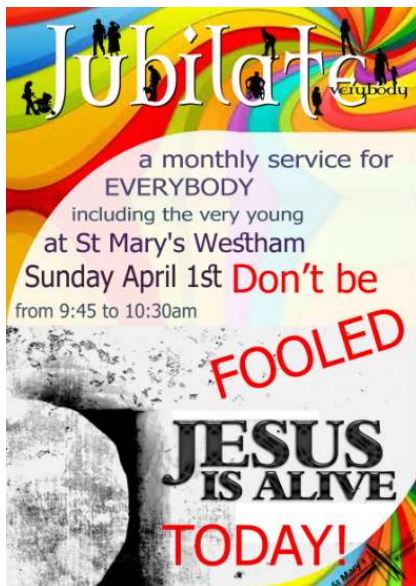
**Ron Davies** is home and is recovering well.
